



School Safety Leadership & Supervision Course

Training Description:

This comprehensive 2-day (16-Hour) course is specifically designed for the law enforcement or school security executive assigned to the educational setting and/or school and college administrator responsible for the management school safety operations. This course will provide advanced topics and theories beyond the Basic Level Course to assist the executive administrator perform their ever evolving duties. Course instruction will focus on the management and supervision of line level officers who are assigned to work within the school setting as School Resource Officers (SROs) and/or School Based Security Officers. Additionally, this course would be beneficial for school based administrators assigned to oversee school based law enforcement and safety programs.

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Have an understanding roles and responsibilities for school based law enforcement officers and the unique partnership between the school/school district and the law enforcement agency
- Identify the causes of violence on school campuses and strategies to address them
- Understand the school based officer selection and interview process
- Be able to compare and contrast the content of various law enforcement / school SRO Contracts for Service
- Better understand school related law, as it pertains to law enforcement/security working within the school setting
- Better understand the unique components of a school critical incident plan and homeland security preparation plan
